

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ALDERHOLT MILL, ALDERHOLT ROAD, ALDERHOLT

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Alderholt Road, at Alderholt Mill Bridge, Alderholt for a distance of approximately 50 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 1 July 2019 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 July 2019. The closure will be in operation between 09:00hrs and 16:00hrs daily.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

Please note that the dates are a window of opportunity and the road may not be closed for the whole duration stated above and the works are weather dependant. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
