

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DAGGONS ROAD, ALDERHOLT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Daggons Road, Alderholt from outside South Lodge, Daggons Road to the junction with Highwood Close (in both directions), a distance of approximately 210 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 10:00 until 14:00 on 18th January 2021 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18th January 2021.

This Notice will enable BT to carry out periodic pole test examination on two telephone poles
