Following the Council's decision to proceed with legal representation, a number of questions have been raised regarding the Council's finances and communication. We hope the information shared below will answer the majority of those, but should you have any further questions please do reach out the to the Parish Clerk (clerk@alderholtparishcouncil.gov.uk) and we'll endeavour to answer them in due course.

The Council holds funds which are allocated to a number of projects around the village, and including the money earmarked to cover legal representation at the upcoming Planning Inquiry, the estimated allocation of funds currently stands at:

The decision to seek legal and expert witness representation was not taken lightly but the Council firmly believes it is a worthwhile investment in the village, strengthening Dorset Council's defence of their initial rejection and ensuring the adverse impact to our Parish is represented.
