

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B3078 CRANBORNE ROAD, ALDERHOLT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It came in to operation on 23 October 2025 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 October 2025. Works will take place between 0900 and 1600 and the road will be open outside of these times and also over the weekend.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council safe access to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

[i] To impose a temporary road closure on Cranborne Road, Alderholt as indicated by signs on site.

[ii] To impose a temporary clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Cranborne Road, Alderholt.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
