

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RINGWOOD ROAD, ALDERHOLT

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles, cyclists and horse riders will be prohibited from proceeding along Ringwood Road, Alderholt between Marshlands and Foxhill Farm, a distance of approximately 160 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 15th September 2025 and remain in force for five days, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19th September 2025.

This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to carry out urgent main repair works in the highway.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
