

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH E34/33, ALDERHOLT

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists will be prohibited from proceeding along Footpath E34/33, Alderholt from grid reference SU 11188 14058 to grid reference SU 11480 14589, a distance of approximately 800 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 1st October 2026 for a period of 26 weeks.

This Order is required to allow National Grid to carry out essential works to their power lines.

The route that will be closed is marked on the map below between points A and B.
