

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BATTERLEY DROVE, CRANBORNE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders will be prohibited from proceeding along Batterley Drive, Cranborne between Gotham Farm and Vale Acre Farm, a distance of approximately 200 metres north. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between on 6th July 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8th July 2026.

**This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to carry out disconnection of water supply in the highway.**

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
