# **Presentations**

#### Alderholt Recreation Association (ARA)

Mr S Rose of the ARA gave a presentation about the history of the recreation ground which is run and managed by the ARA.


This year will see the recreation ground celebrating its 50<sup>th</sup> year anniversary, to commemorate this there will be an exhibition at the Alderholt Fete. In the early 1970's the then District Council formulated a new Local Plan and the Parish Council was asked for their input regarding sites for a recreation ground. Various sites were considered but many proved to be unsuitable for one reason or another and in the end the current site was purchased by the Parish Council in 1975 for £15,000, using a loan from the PWLB – it was paid off within 10yrs. Only sports in Alderholt at the time was football but with purchase of the recreation ground the cricket club reformed, also rugby and tennis. The field still needed developing and to be able to acquire grant aid the ARA charity was formed. The Parish Council awarded a grant to the ARA of a £1000 to start the process of building the Pavilion, which was completed in 1981. The ARA is a voluntary organisation and the Parish Council contribute towards it and think it is a lot but it is only a small amount. There is currently both a very strong cricket club and youth football club using the recreation ground. It is not just a place for sport but for everyone to use and enjoy it including dog walkers. Thank you for using it.

# **Alderholt Fete 2025**

This is the third year of holding the fete which helps to promote organisations in the village. Thanks were given to the ARA for allowing the fete to be held at the recreation ground. There will be a fancy dress parade which will be a sports theme to recognise the recreation ground's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary. A presentation was given to show what entertainment will be happening during the day and the times. A list of stall holders was also provided. It was also pointed out that volunteers are needed to assist on the day.

# To discuss having a Citizen of the Year agenda item for future Annual Parish Meeting

Various feedback received with one member of the public stating they didn't think it was worth it. #### Questions

- Q. Concerned raised regarding the state of the ditch at the Pennyfarthings development. Ditch important as impacts AHRG. Need to demand something is done.
- Q. Is the Parish Council going to continue with the bus service? It was confirmed that the Parish Council has funding secured to continue the bus service for at least the next three years.
- Q. What is happening with CIL monies recently received, can they be used to extend the path around the Amanda Harris Recreation Ground? As funds only just received no decisions have been made yet as to how they will be used.
